GIRLS SCHOOL UNIFORM

SIXTH FORM

- A good quality, plain black (no fabric pattern), business suit comprising of
 - Classic design single breasted, buttoned jacket with collar
 - Classic straight **knee-length** skirt in same fabric as jacket. Skirts should be modest (including rear splits) not figure-hugging and preferably lined so they don't 'ride up' when walking.
- Plain white blouse with collar and long sleeves (optional short sleeve in the summer)
- Black or natural tights (not patterned)
- Plain black leather shoes with heel no higher than 7cm (no stiletto heels)
- Plain, no trim, **round or v-neck** fine knit jumper or cardigan in school colours (black, purple or grey) or School jumper with trim.
- Outdoor coats, if worn, must be black or navy (no logos)
- School scarf or plain scarf in school colours (black, grey or purple)

Upper Sixth pupils may wear a School or plain (without trim) round or v-neck fine knit jumper or cardigan in a colour of their choice.

- Sports clothing and equipment will be required dependent upon activities undertaken
 - Pupils chosen to represent the School in sports teams may need to purchase further School sportswear
 - All pupils must have a PE shirt in their house colour
- Non-team players should have skorts, shorts or tracksuit bottoms purchased from Schoolblazer. An optional purple midlayer is also permitted, no other tops are allowed

<input type="checkbox"/>	Plain black or dark grey socks
<input type="checkbox"/>	Waistcoat to match suit or plain, no trim, v-neck fine knit jumper or cardigan in school colours (black, purple or grey) or School jumper with trim.

SCHOOL UNIFORM REGULATIONS

General

- ◆ A tidy, clean appearance is expected at all times. Pupils are to ensure that their clothing and shoes are clean, in good order and correctly worn
- ◆ Every article must be clearly marked with the owner's name, including shoes
- ◆ Hair must be of a "natural" colour. Styles of a bizarre nature are not allowed
- ◆ Jackets must be worn at all times around school. Shirts and blouses must be tucked in at all times
- ◆ No body piercing is allowed
- ◆ In winter plain black, grey or blazer purple gloves may be worn. Coats, scarves and gloves should not be worn inside school buildings
- ◆ Hats are not part of everyday school uniform

Girls

- ◆ Make up must be discreet
- ◆ Jewellery: All jewellery must be discreet and of a style suitable for a professional office environment
 - Earrings are limited to one pair to be worn in the lobe
 - Earrings in the upper part of the ear are strictly forbidden
 - Jewellery cannot be worn or taped over during sports
- ◆ Hair must be kept neat.

Boys

- ◆ Hair must be cut conservatively, kept tidy and clear of the face, off the collar and ears
- ◆ Faces must be clean shaven
- ◆ Jewellery: One bracelet may be worn. No other jewellery is permitted
 - Belts must be plain black leather with plain buckle
